From Miami or Ft-Lauderdale airports:

- Take the Florida turnpike South to US 1
- Exit on US 1 South go 35 miles passing Key Largo
- When you get to the Circle K in Tavernier (MM 94.5) take a Left on Burton Drive
- It will be the 3rd street on your right called Banyan Lane
- The marina will be on your left and it is called Curtis Marina.

Once you get to The Florida Keys it's easier to find where you're going if you know the "mile marker". US - 1 is our main highway in the Keys and you'll find little green mile marker signs on the side of the road starting with Mile Marker 127 in Florida City all the way down to Mile Marker Zero in Key West.
